

TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

CONSULTANT FOR DEVELOPING A CLINICAL PRACTICE HANDBOOK OF STROKE SURVIVORS AND FAMILIES ON SPEECH AND LANGUAGE THERAPY

1. Overview

Vietnam Assistance for the Handicapped (VNAH) is a non-governmental organization with over 30 years of experience working in Vietnam. Its mission is to support persons with disabilities (PWDs) in Vietnam in improving mobility, functional activities, and overall quality of life.

Currently, with support from the Inclusion III-b Project funded by CRS / the U.S. Department of State, VNAH is supporting the development of rehabilitation human resources and rehabilitation services for persons with disabilities in Dong Nai Province (merged from the former Binh Phuoc Province and former Dong Nai Province as of July 2025).

With the aim of supporting persons with disabilities affected by Agent Orange from the war in Dong Nai Province, VNAH works with provincial departments, experts, and local healthcare staff to improve the quality of rehabilitation services for these beneficiaries. Therefore, VNAH cooperates with medical universities and domestic rehabilitation experts, such as those in Can Tho and Ho Chi Minh City, to support the development of a *Clinical Practice Handbook for stroke survivors and families on Speech and Language Therapy* to use at hospitals and at home.

2. Objective

- Working with SLT from different settings to develop priorities of SLT intervention/exercise for stroke survivors and families.
- Compose and complete a Clinical Practice Handbook for stroke survivors and families on speech and language therapy to use at hospitals and at home.
